I am requesting funding for the Northwest YMCA Facility in fiscal year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the YMCA of Metropolitan Fort Worth, located at 512 Lamar Street, Suite 400, Fort Worth, Texas, 76102.

The funding would be used for the construction of the new Northwest YMCA Facility that would service the Eagle Mountain/Saginaw communities.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the new facility will serve a variety of adults and students through four primary communities (Saginaw, Azle, Lake Worth, and White Settlement) and four different independent school districts (Eagle-Mountain Saginaw, Azle, Lake Worth, and White Settlement ISDs), and will be the primary community meeting space for all communities within its location.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2): The acquisition, construction, reconstruction, or installation (including design features and improvements with respect to such construction, reconstruction, or installation that promote energy efficiency) of public works, facilities (except for buildings for the general conduct of government), and site or other improvements.
